Applications are invited for the above full time (40 hours per week) position. The successful applicant will work as part of a team specialising in the diagnosis of animal diseases, and laboratory research studies related to the development of animal vaccines. The job will involve general support duties for the lab team. Duties will include booking in and preparing samples, basic equipment maintenance and calibration, stock checks, preparation of reagents and fixing and staining cells. Compliance with Good Laboratory Practice and ISO:17025 will be required at all times. Experience is not essential as full training will be given.
