Description

The main techniques involved are cell and viral culture, a variety of serological techniques principally ELISAs and neutralisation tests, and PCR for pathogen detection and genetic testing. The majority of our tests are developed and validated in-house.

Responsibilities

The individual selected for this position will be expected to participate in all routine testing activities including working in our high containment laboratory after an appropriate period of training. Compliance with Good Laboratory Practice (GLP) and Good Manufacturing Practice (GMP) will be required at all times.

Qualifications

This is an exciting opportunity for an individual with a degree in one of the Biological Sciences. Experience of working in an ISO, GLP or GMP environment would be an advantage but is not essential.
